



The above view shews the interior of the Box or Hopper. Distribution is effected by means of the stars, which revolve on a special dead flat steel plate forming the bottom of the Hopper. The stars are carried in bearings fitted with brass bushes, and may be entirely removed (for cleaning and lubricating purposes) by simply taking out a split pin at the bottom of each star. The design and movement of the stars is such that whilst ensuring regular and even distribution, the Manure is not stirred or churned into a paste.

When sowing light material, e.g., Soot or Manures difficult to distribute, tilt the Hopper well back by the lever provided. This arrangement also enables the Hopper to be kept level when operating on hilly ground.

**SPECIAL NOTE.** It is essential that all working parts be kept well lubricated, and beforebeing stored away the Machine is thoroughly cleaned. This can be best accomplished by washing out with a solution of hot water and soda, afterwards drying and wiping over all parts with a mixture of Oil and Paraffin. Do not allow the Machine to stand for any period with Manures contained in the Hopper as chemical action will occur and cause serious corrosion and decay





I have used it for distributing Basic Slag, Superphosphate, Ammonia, Nitrate of Soda, Nitrolim, Potash, and mixtures of the above. It will sow from half hundredweight per acre up to the Maximum Quantity required, and there has not been any clogging even when sowing Manures difficult to distribute, such as Superphosphate and Ammonia.

I find the Machine very Easy in Draught, and I consider two of its best points are the simplicity in operation and ease in cleaning.
